Upon successful completion of the course, students will be able to:

- Demonstrate their knowledge of the fundamental aspects of criminal investigation, including familiarity with preliminary investigative methods of the first responder at a crime scene, processing and preserving the crime scene, handling evidence, and other crime scene duties.
- Reconstruct a crime by employing critical thinking, reasoning, and investigative skills and techniques, including determining how, when and why a crime was committed, what type of crime was committed, and who committed the crime.
- Apply effective interview and interrogation skills, and intuitive investigation skills, to obtain valuable information from crime victims, witnesses, informants, and suspects, to solve crimes.
