

# Smithsonian still Life Through Time

"Life Through Time" is an exhibit formerly housed at the California Academy of Sciences before its demolition and reconstruction in a radically different form. It had been threaded through a series of rooms that follow the progress of organic evolution through a succession of geologic periods.

The exhibit is now located in the Science Building of San Francisco City College and its layout has been adapted to conform to its new home.

Examine the contents of each room (or section) and for each "room":

- Create an appropriate and new title of your own for it.
- Record the span of time that the room covers (e.g. from 300 million to 150 million years ago).
- Describe what the earth was like physically during that period.
- Describe briefly and specifically one major evolutionary event of that period.
- Identify the main evolutionary concept that the room exemplifies?
