

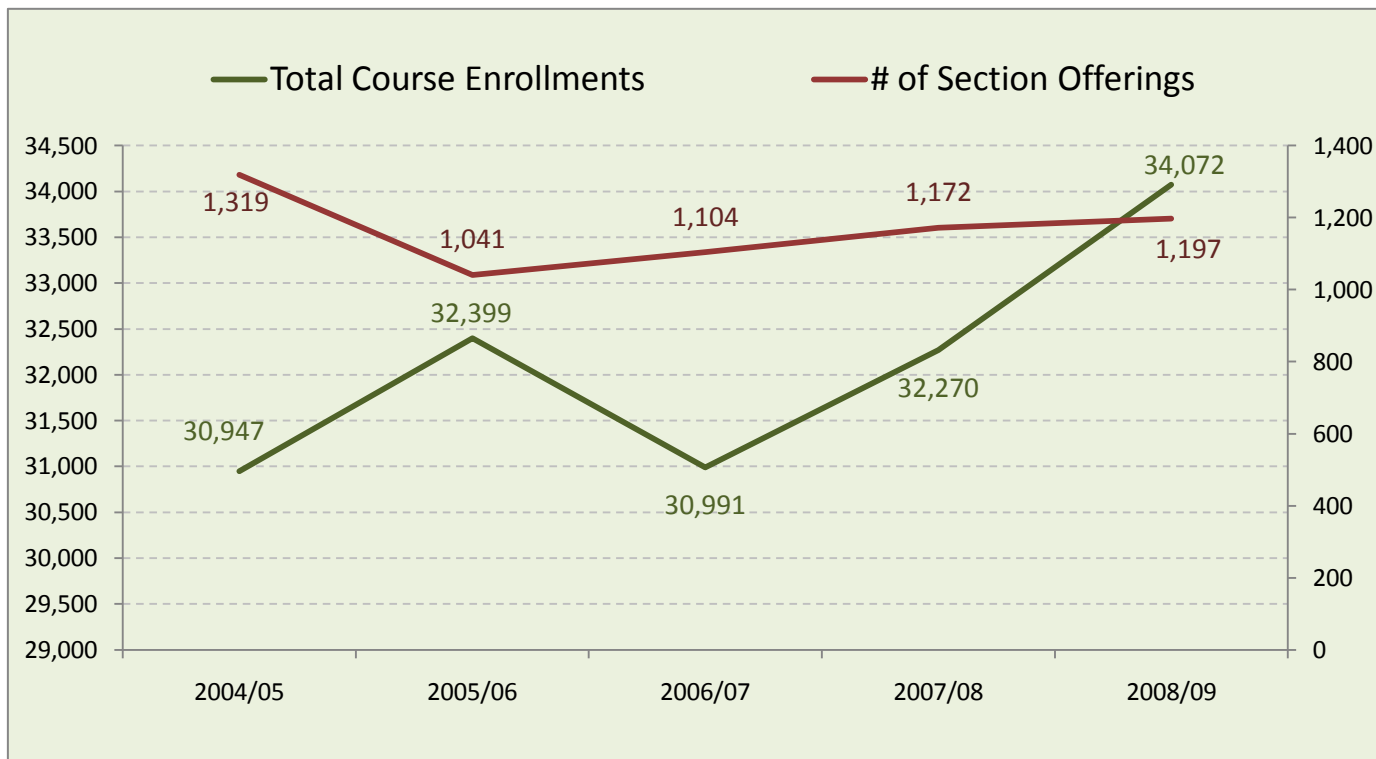

- Ave Enrollment per Section** is the average number of students per section (Average Class Size).

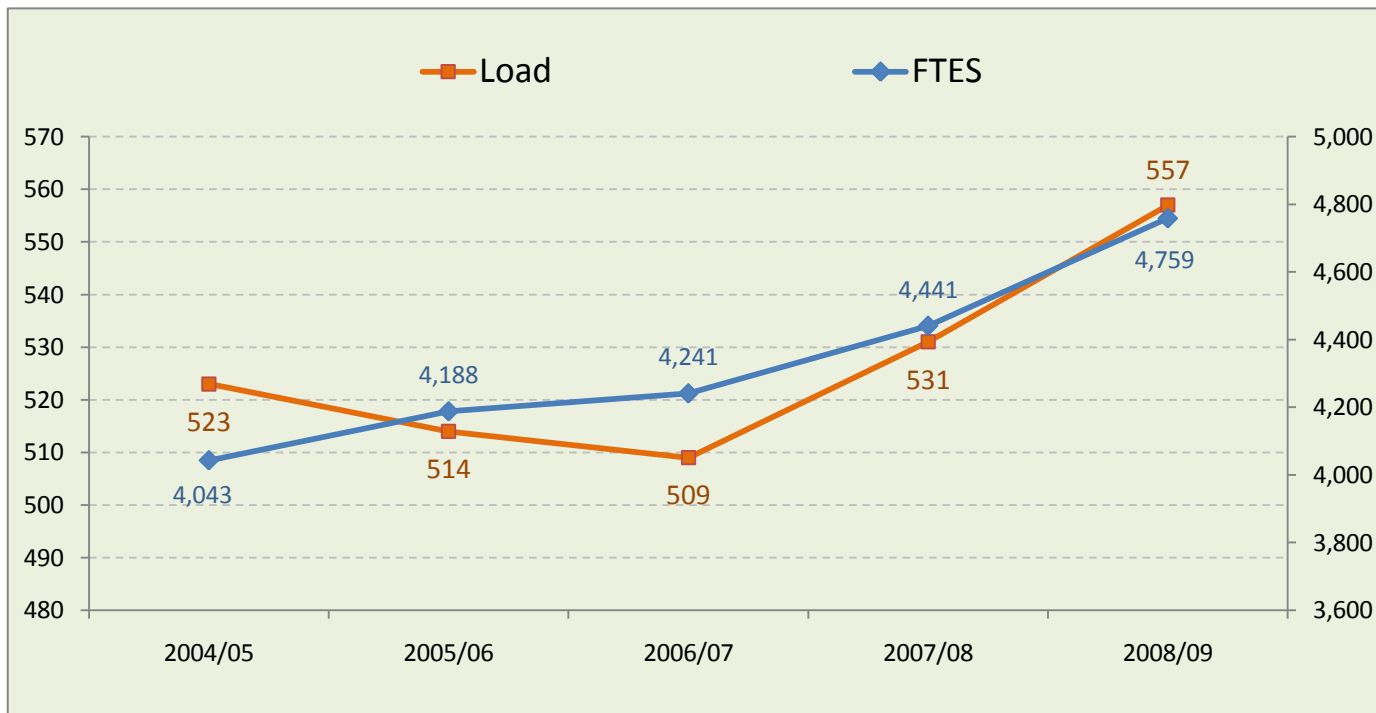

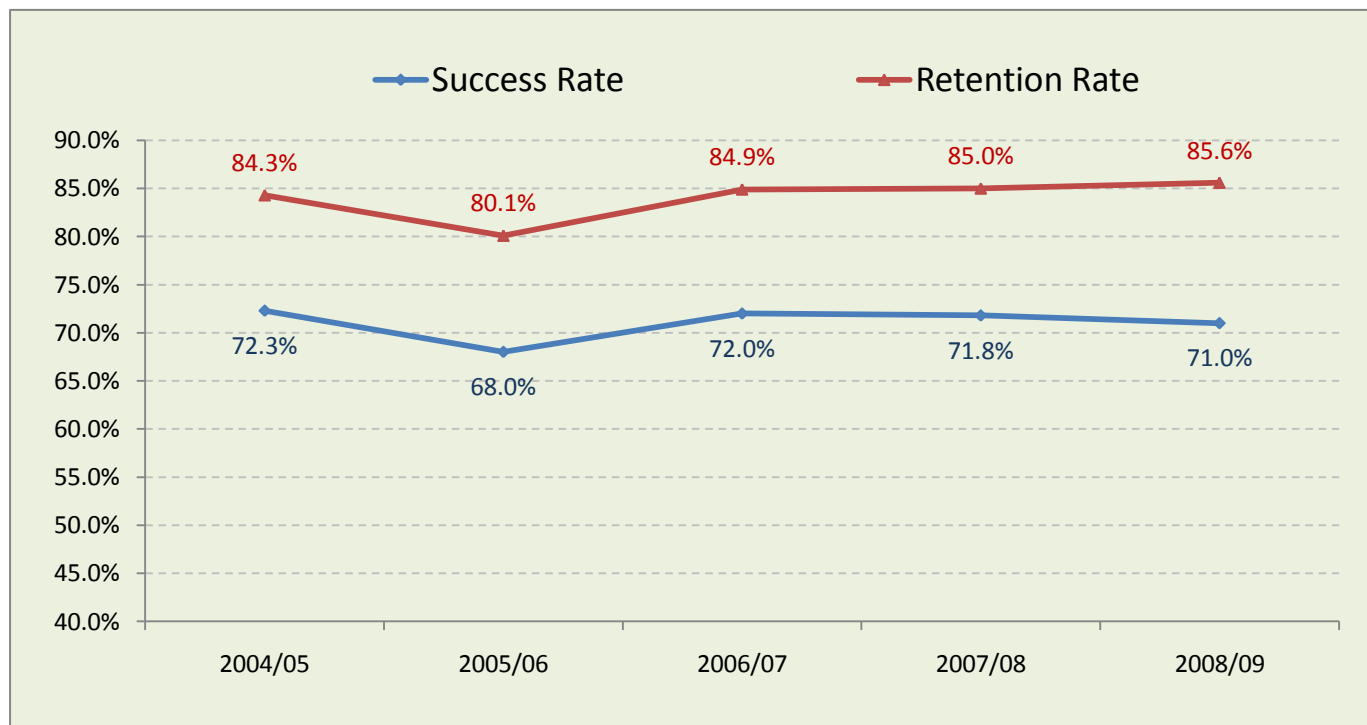

Student Performance Profile



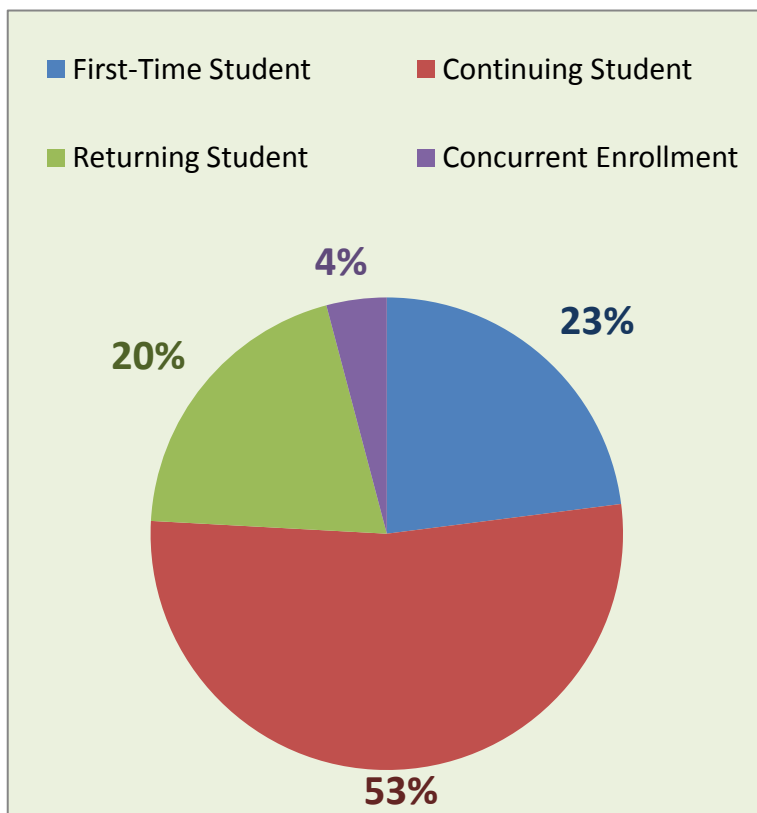

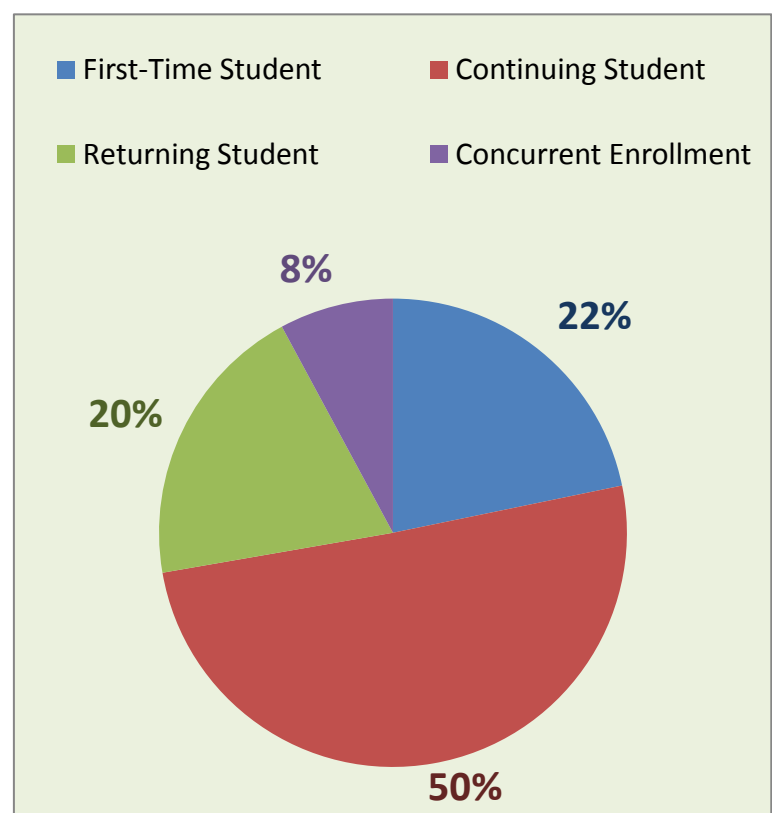

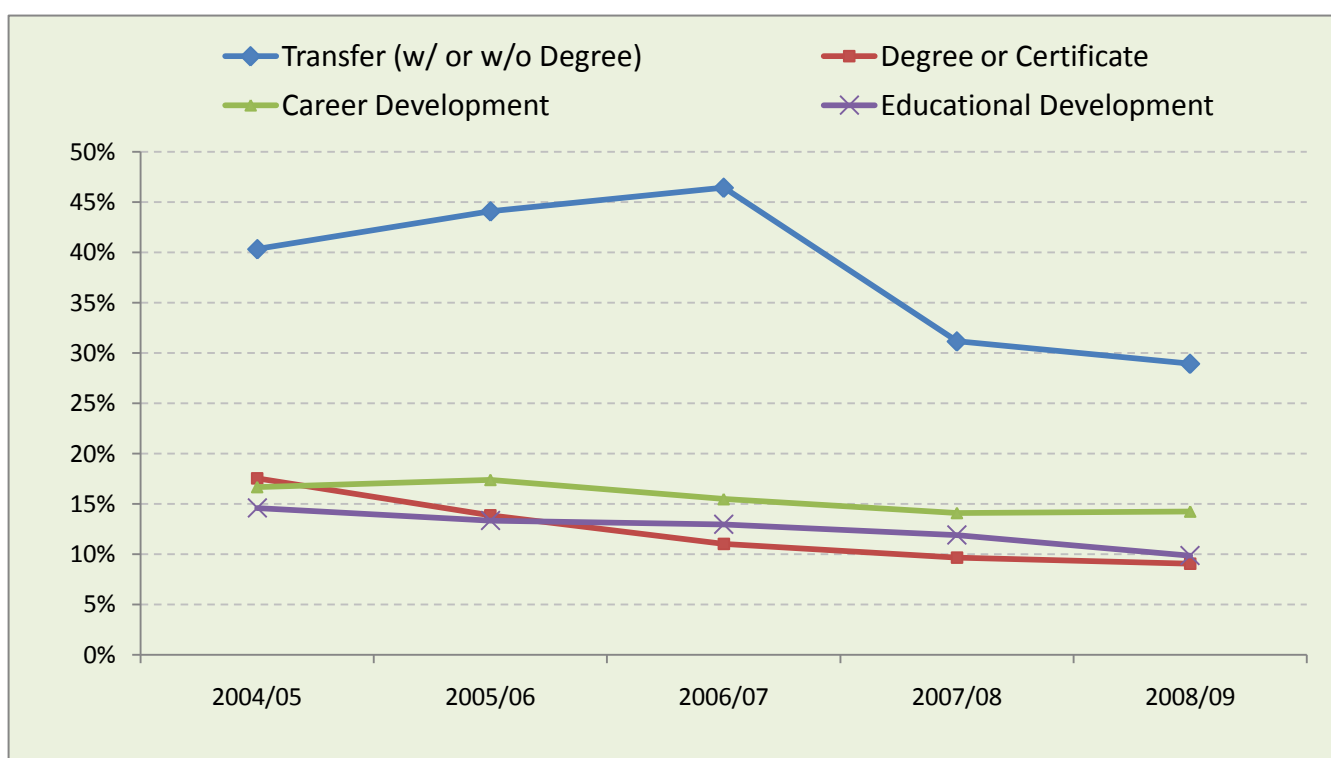

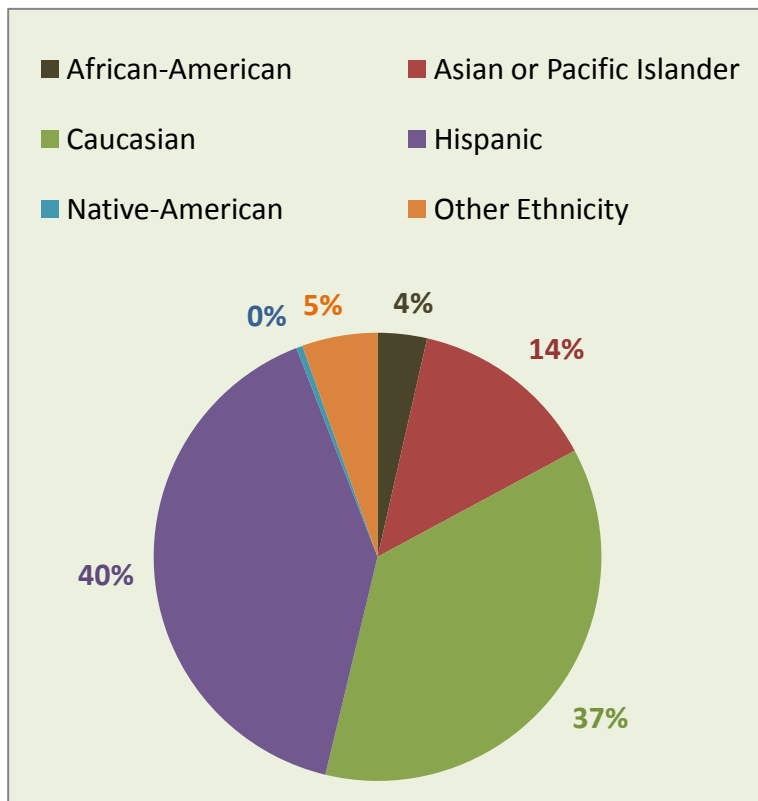

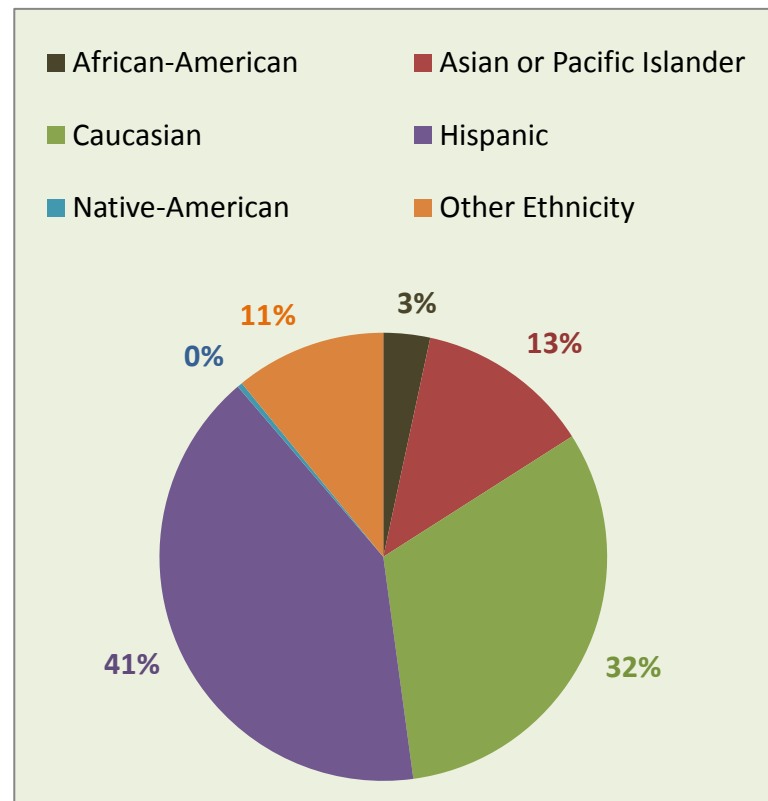

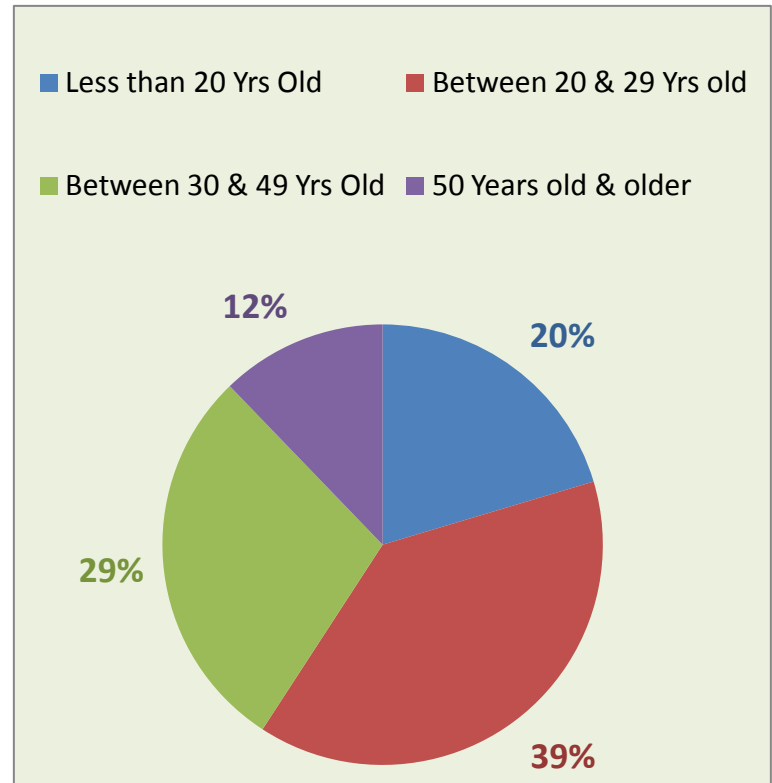
