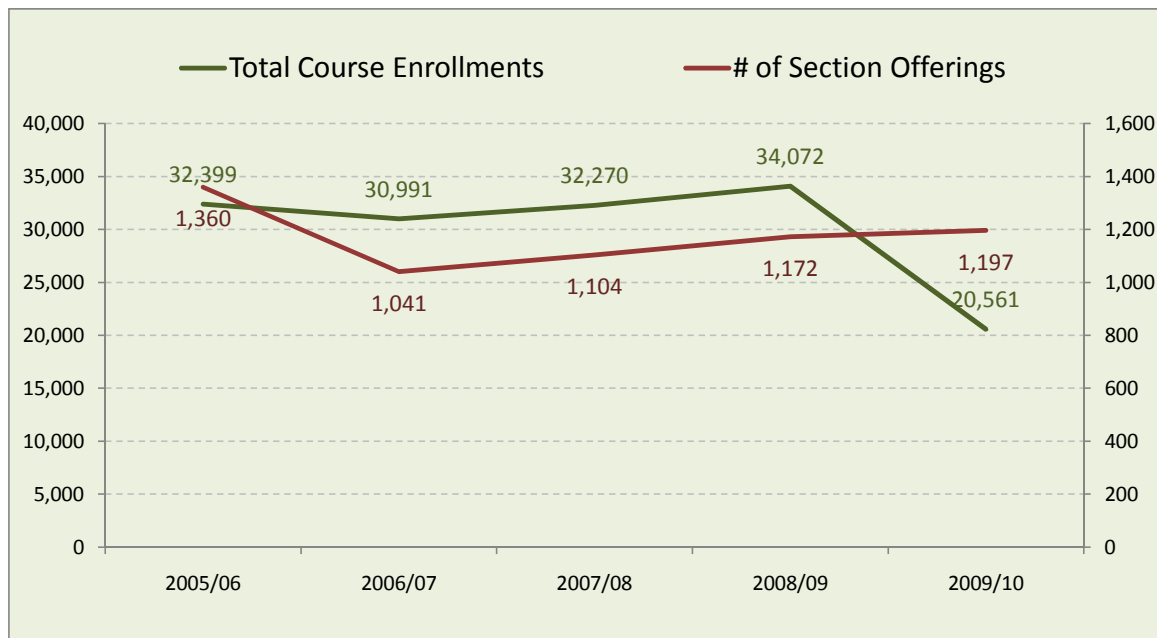

Ave Enrollment per Section is the average number of students per section (Average Class Size).

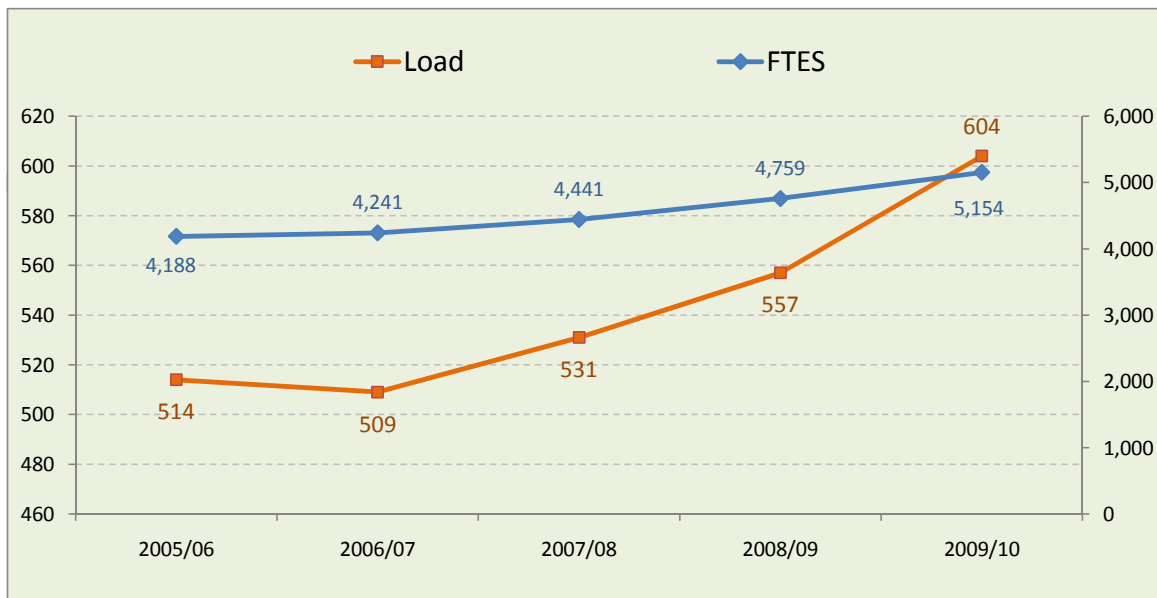

Load is the ratio of WSCH to FTE and a standard measure of department efficiency.



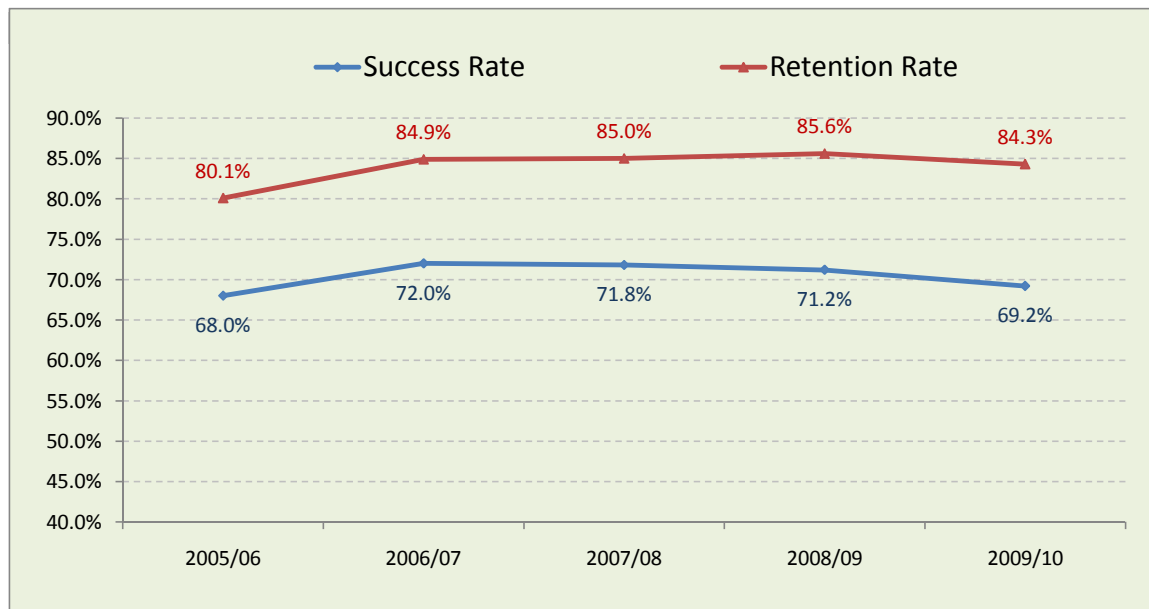

Student Performance Profile



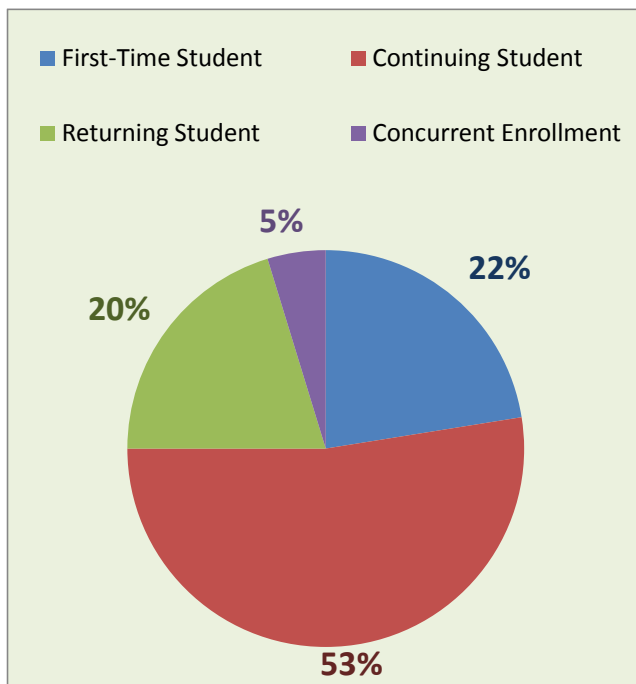

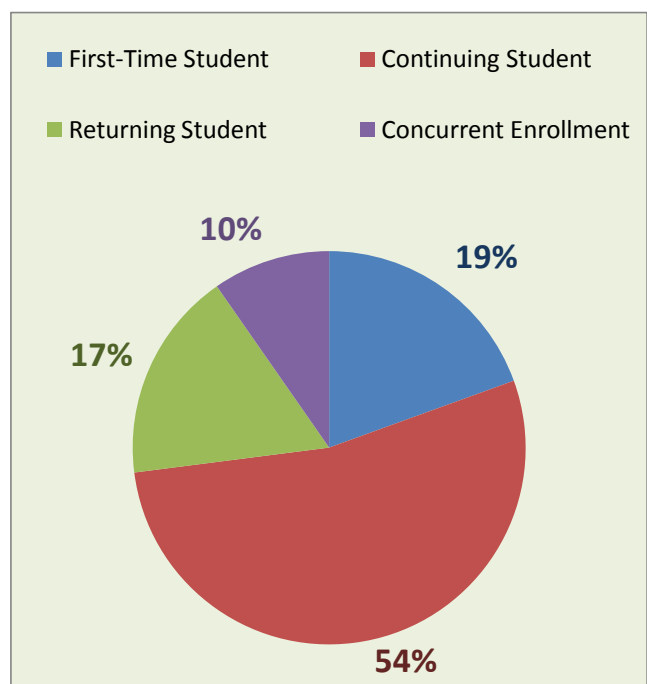

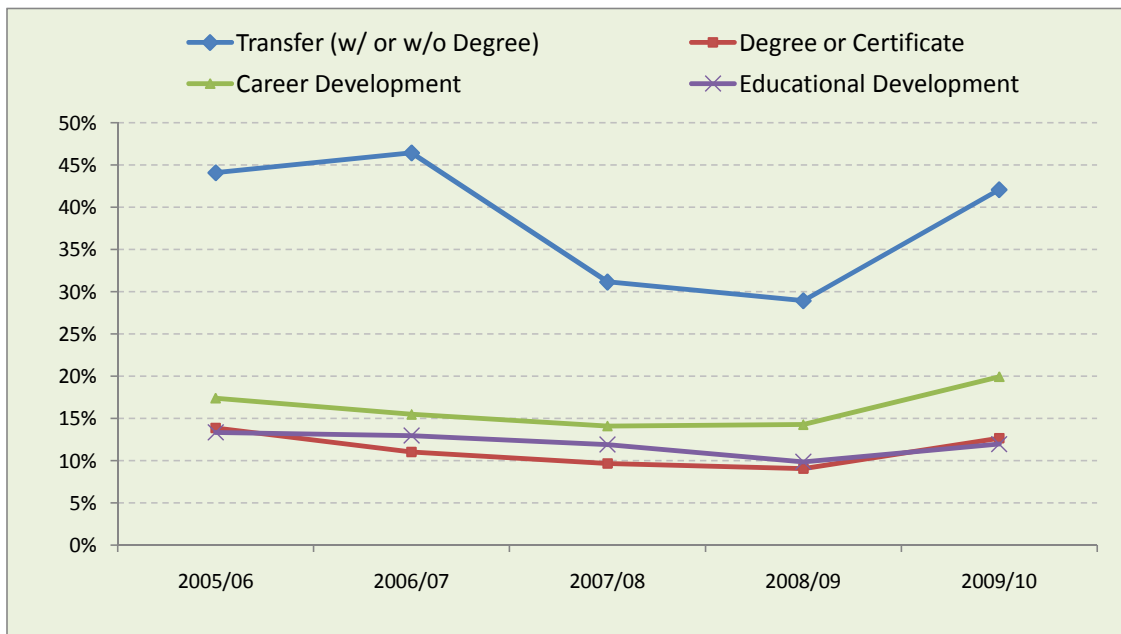

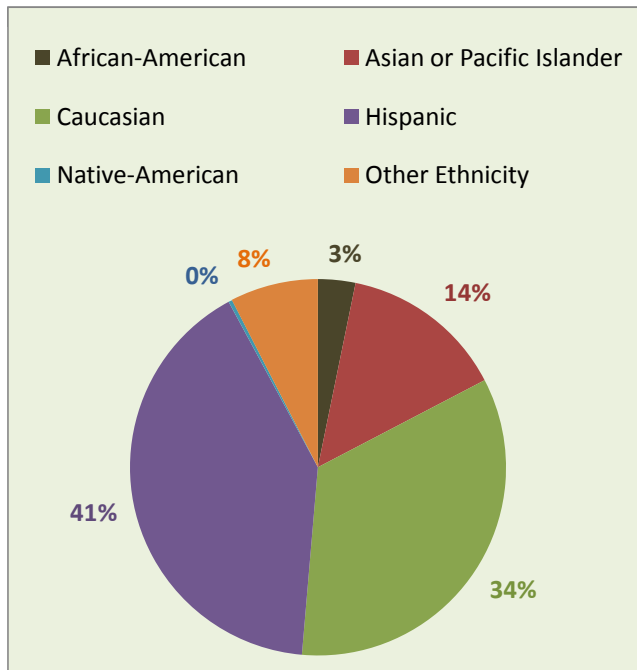

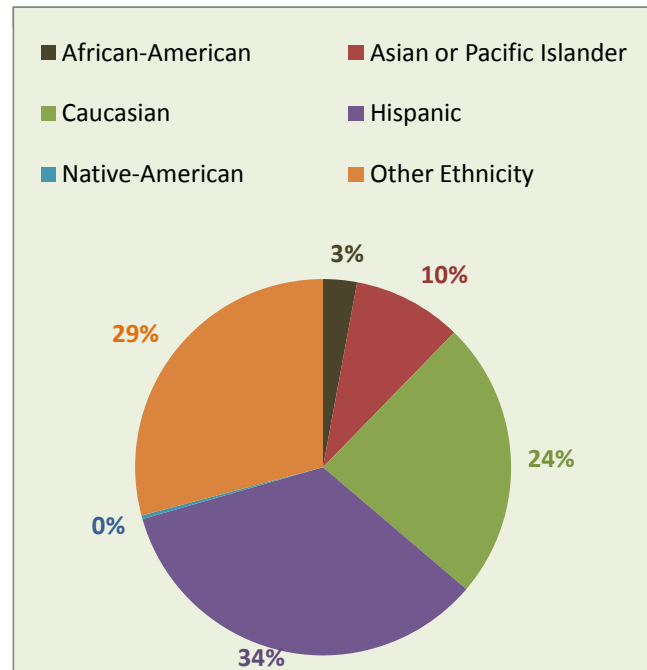

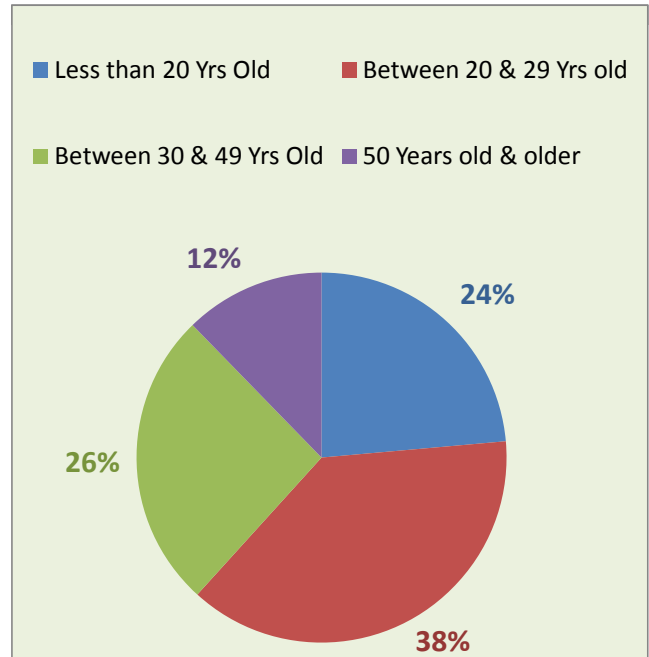
