Math Supplement Information :

This supplemental assistance class will provide you with individualized lessons in mathematics arranged and supervised in The Learning Center (RM 5100.) This class is an opportunity to **practice** and **apply** the mathematics you learn in your basic skills math classes. This class can also help you to **review** those math skills for which you need further practice and exposure. This will be accomplished through an individualized program of instructional activities including videos, computers, manipulatives, and problem solving. Group workshops and study skills workshops are also provided.

Units and Grading

24 supervised lab hours is required for 0.5 units

48 supervised lab hours is required for 1.0 units

Credit will be based on attendance and activities. This is a **Credit/No Credit** course.

Required Materials

Binder and paper 8 1/2 inch by 11 inch

Activities

After initial diagnosis by your Math 650 instructor, you will be assigned to a combination of **assigned tutoring hours** with a specific Graduate tutor and **supervised lab hours** in the Learning center. These hours will include reviewing homework, learning skill topics, practice exams, and cooperative problem solving.

Lab folder

Your lab hours will be recorded in a lab folder by your Math 650 instructor. **You must document** each lab meeting in the TLC by :

- 1) logging onto the log-in computer under the **Math 650 BV** class, **AND**
- 2) by the end of each lab meeting either **verbally** describe the time duration & content of your lab meeting to the Math 650 instructor in Room 5107, or **submit** a record of service form to room 5107 (get this form from your instructor.) Any time spent in the TLC which is not recorded as indicated above will not be accepted for credit in Math 650.

Attendance

Attendance is mandatory and recorded for each lab hour. Lack of attendance undermines your own effort in this class. Each student will have an individual weekly schedule of work in The Learning Center. This class allows a **maximum of 2** one-hour lab sessions **per day** in TLC.
