Student	GPA	School Average GPA	School Standard Deviation
Thuy	2.7	3.2	0.8
Vichet	87.0	75.0	20.0
Kamala	8.6	8.0	0.4

$$Z_c = \frac{(8.6-8)}{0.4} = 1.5 \quad Z_v = \frac{(87-75)}{20} = 0.60 \quad Z_t = \frac{(2.7-3.20)}{0.8} = -0.625$$

Kamala because her z-score is highest
