

Lesson Structure

Math 200 Online

Written homework is in the text book and is due on exam days but in order to be successful in this class you must do homework daily. Do not wait until the last minute to do your homework: it does not work. Follow the structure found on the Sample Written Homework document. Plan on spending between eight and twelve hours per week on this course.

Online homework is found in CourseCompass under Online Homework. Each assignment has a due date but it is a good idea to work ahead. You may repeat homework and quizzes as many times as you like until the deadline. If you procrastinate to the deadline you run the risk of not being able to complete the assignment. If you are working on the assignment just before the deadline and there is a problem with CourseCompass then you will not be able to complete the assignment. If you feel that CourseCompass is not recording your answer correctly, click the Ask My Instructor button and send me an email describing the problem.
