SOCC meeting recap	<p>VV gave a recap of SOCC (Skyline Organization and Club Council)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The ASSC is doing a costume drive, a coat drive and a canned food drive. Ceramics agreed to participate. ASSC would like to break the Guinness Book of World Records for the most people (>508) dressed in Halloween costumes in one place for 10 minutes. Some ceramics club members agreed to participate. There will be an event for victims of the San Bruno fire (similar to the Haiti Relief event). The ASSC would like each club to participate. Club funds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dr. Stephen Hearne donated \$100 to the club. TS recapped available funds \$1413. Of which \$700, is from ceramics sale and available for ceramic studio materials purchase. There was discussion on what items to purchase i.e. nice banding wheels, more turntables, spray bottles, clay gun, kiln selves, large bead rack, stilts, sponges, safety masks, bucket dollies, a small kiln for glaze testing. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to authorize TS to make the purchase. TS will also be requesting other items from Skyline College such as new wheels. TS discussed having a visiting artist. Ceramics club will be requesting SOCC funding for this semester and this money could be used for a visiting artist and advertising for visiting artist. It will be a campus wide invite on a Monday or Wednesday. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to request SOCC funding and ask Susannah Israel to visit skyline and demo her work.

Consensus was some grouping OK. Some discussion about prime location by the door. Discussion on jewelry close to register.
