7	Classes for WIT are not always readily available in Skyline especially during the Summer. Not everybody can go during Spring or Fall. It would be nice to have the same classes offered in CSM or Canada. Classes are so limited and everybody would like to travel all the way to CSM or Canada and enroll in City College (a pain).
8	"I came to Skyline College and fell into the arms of a family of faculty and staff who cared not only about my success, but also about the many bumpy roads that I have traveled along the way, thus, helping me to understand that it is because of where I've been that I am able to stand in the place of where I stand today." I have been able to accomplish more in my life in the last four and a half years since being a student as Skyline College, than I have in the past twenty years (excluding my husband and children).

I believe Skyline does a great job in protecting the rights of women by posting flyers that advocate for women's rights, as well as providing a non-hostile environment for women to learn.
143	I did not know that services were available. You need to get the word out more. Where do I go? To whom do I speak? Etc.
144	I am a student that hates math. i dropped out of school because of math. now i'm back and was terrified of taking the math calss but did it anyway, My teacher is the best teacher i have ever had in my college experience.

146	I have had no problem with scheduling a course that does not interfere with my work.
147	I feel everything is OK.
148	I am returning to school after a very bad accident in which I broke my back. It has taken me a few years to be able to manage the pain to a level where I could sit through a class. The problem I am having is that my pain is most acute in the afternoon and evenings. The classes I need to retrain as a paralegal are only being offered at night. It is difficult to sit through the three hour classes in a right handed desk when I am left-handed and my back is spasming. I am considering withdrawing because I sometimes cannot concentrate at night. I also do not have internet access at home, and my back pain limits me a few times a week from driving up to the campus. I have heard that there is an office for disabled students that might be able to help. I am hoping to go there soon.

193	The climate of the campus seems safe. Two nights a week I am on campus until 9:30pm, and I have always felt safe.
194	I am actually a part-time instructor at Skyline College and I am taking a few computer classes to help me with my work.
195	My experience at Skyline College has been fulfilling. I do wish that there are more programs for women that are well publicized. Not everybody on campus knows about the child services we offer. I know there's programming available, and WIT could still be developed, but the program itself isn't well known around campus.
