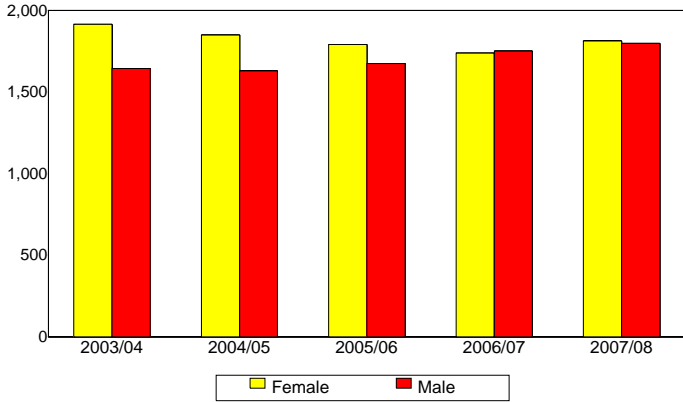

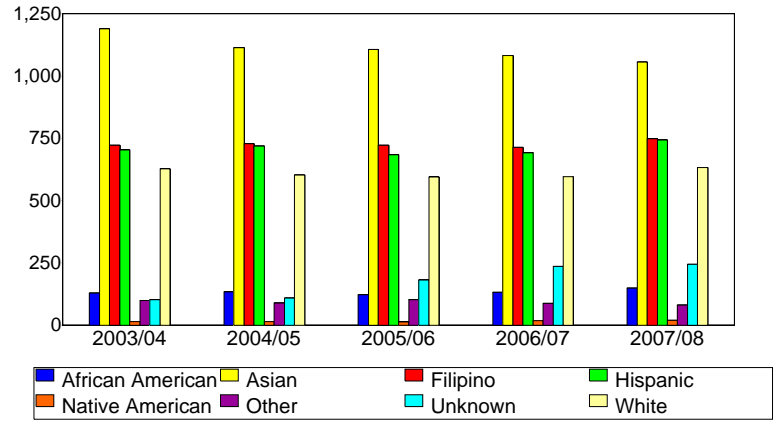

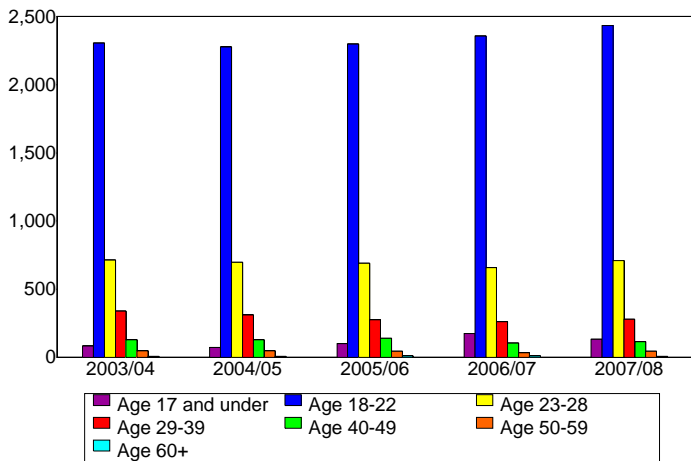
Enrollment by Gender



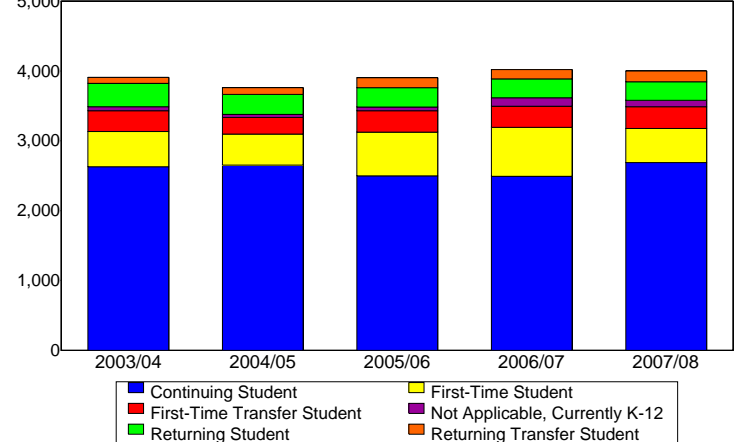
Enrollment by Ethnicity



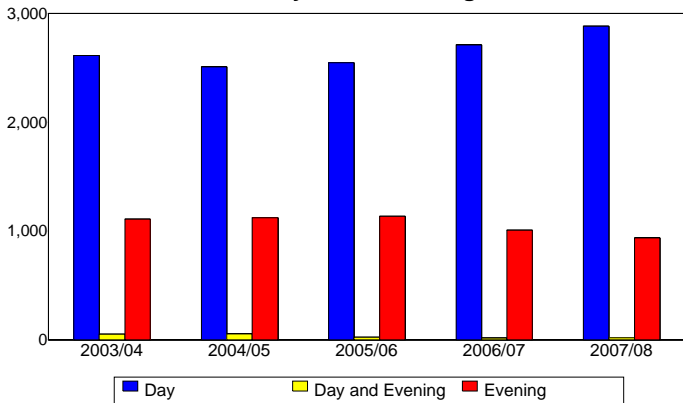
Enrollment by Student Age



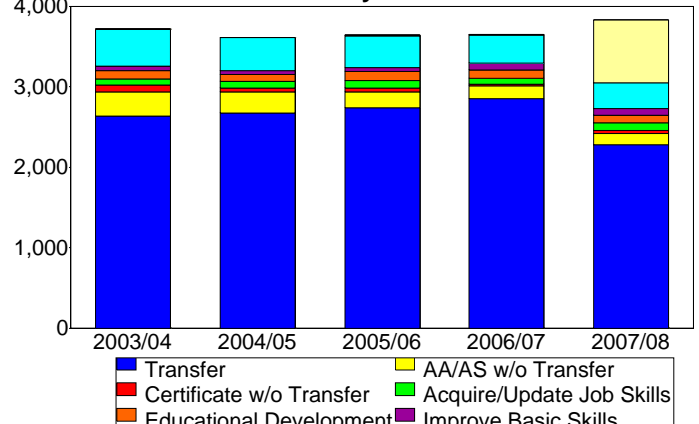
Enrollment by Enrollment Status
