



## San Mateo County Human Services Agency Wins National Association of Counties Top Award for Gateway and Bio-Manufacturing Program Partnership

Citing Innovation in Human Services, The National Association of Counties recognizes San Mateo County Human Services Agency for the top program in the nation for its collaboration with **Skyline's Biotech Certificate Program** and for **Skyline** and **Cañada's Gateway Program**.
