

## SMCCCD 2011-2015 Five Year Construction Plan (5YCP)

In 2009, the Board of Trustees authorized submission of the District's 2011-2015 Five-Year Capital Construction Plan (5YCP) and the related Initial Project Proposals (IPPs) and Final Project Proposals (FPPs) to the California Community Colleges System Office. Submittal of a five year construction plan is an annual requirement for colleges seeking state funding for major capital projects such as new construction or reconstruction of existing facilities. The 5YCP takes into account an important criterion for campus facilities planning: capacity-to-load ratios. The capacity-to-load ratios are measured for different categories of space including lecture halls laboratories, offices, libraries, and audio/visual support spaces. Capital projects that will be active during the 2011-2015 fiscal years are as follows:
