**Methodology:**

- 1) High school graduates data came from the California Department of Education. SMCCCD and 3 college enrollment data came from Banner.
- 2) High school students who graduated in 2004-05 were tracked in our Banner for a year. For example, those 232 graduates in 2004-05 from fall 2005 and spring 06 semesters to see if any of them enrolled in our district. The results were: A total of 83 (22.6% of the total Half Moon Bay 2004-5 graduates) enrolled with most of them going to CSM.
- 3) Dark green cells denote colleges with more than 10% of a high school's graduates enrolling. This way, the table shows visually the "feeder high schools" for each of our 3 colleges.
