### **Checklist of Required Documents**

We accept scanned documents for application purposes, but original or certified documents must be mailed to the International Student Program Office at the college of your choice. **Only applications with all of the supporting documents will be considered. Please Note:** Students **under the age of 18** will need to show proof of high school graduation or the equivalent and complete the Authorization for a Minor Student form (smccd.edu/international/minorconsent).

- Complete, sign and return Application for Admission International Students
- Submit proof of English proficiency. A minimum score or higher on any of the following examinations is required for admission: TOEFL 480 (paper based) or 56 iBT (internet based) or IELTS Band 5.5
- Complete the Financial Data Form and submit an official Bank Verification of Funds document in U.S. dollars
- Submit original or certified English translations of your high school/university transcripts. For high school equivalencies, click here: Approved High School Equivalencies
- Submit a non-refundable \$50.00 USD application fee by: international money order, bank draft (payable through a U.S. branch) or Application Fee Form. No cash.
- Submit copy of Passport
