Exact opportunities can vary due to such factors as market trends, time of year, and economic outlook. Strong industry sectors for team internships in Japan include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Business & Communications: market research, brand communication, digital marketing, and professional services
- Information Technology & Computer Science: system development, beta testing, API development, product or services launch, and market research
- Marketing & PR: content creation, social media, corporate communications, tourism agencies, NGOs, and more
- Nonprofit & NGO: program development, policy research, data analysis, evaluation reports, and fundraising support
