

Revee Reboredo

Revee is a Political Science and Paralegal Studies student at Skyline College. She began as a concurrent enrollment student studying biotechnology and biomanufacturing in 2023 during high school, and began attending Skyline College full-time in August of 2025. Revee was elected as the Student Trustee for the San Mateo County Community College District in May of 2026, serving as the advocate for over 31,000 students across the district.

Revee's commitment to community service began in 2023. At the age of 15, she compiled a formal proposal to the City of South San Francisco to create a program that provided the youth with safe and free-of-cost recreational spaces after the pandemic. In 2024, Revee was appointed as a Commissioner by the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors to the San Mateo County Youth Commission, where she was later elected as the Community Equity Committee Chair. In this role, she hosted a Necessities Drive in partnership with local homeless shelters to provide residents with hygienic items and clothing. She also authored a resolution that addressed the illegal sale of nitrous oxide in San Mateo County, suggesting fines and the revocation of licenses for businesses involved. The resolution was presented to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors and was passed and adopted in August of 2025. In 2026, Revee began working for the California State Assembly as a Legislative Intern at the district office under Assemblymember Diane Papan of District 21. At this opportunity, Revee has authored a California Bill Proposal that addresses distracted driving in California. This bill would mitigate vehicular accidents in California by increasing legal punishments for distracted driving.

On campus at Skyline College, Revee is a part of the Honors Transfer Program, the Promise Scholars Program, Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society, Associated Students of Skyline College, and she works as a Student Advisor for the Career Services department. Revee also serves as the 2026-2027 Vice President of Advocacy for the Honors Transfer Club at Skyline College.
