

Proof of English Proficiency for Admission to the International Student Program at San Mateo Colleges of Silicon Valley

Cañada College, College of San Mateo, and Skyline College

Applicants can demonstrate English proficiency by fulfilling **one** of the following criteria:

A. Exams

- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)**
 - A minimum qualifying score on the Internet based TOEFL (iBT) is 56
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS)**
 - A minimum qualifying level of Band 5.5
- **Pearson Test of English (PTE)**
 - A minimum qualifying score of 42
- **EIKEN Test in Practical English Proficiency**
 - A minimum qualifying score of Grade 2A
- **GTEC Global Test of English Communication**
 - A minimum qualifying score of 1055
- **Cambridge English Language Assessment**
 - B2 First (FCE) scores of 160-179; C2 Advanced (CAE) scores of 180-199; and C2 Proficiency (CPE) scores of 200+

B. Intensive English Language Schools

Successful completion of the appropriate ESL level or higher at the following schools:

- **Certification of completion of the highest level** from any accredited U.S. intensive English language school.

c. Other

- **Secondary Education:** Earned a high school diploma, or studied for a minimum of 2 years and attained a grade of "C" or better in English in one of the English speaking countries (U.S., U.K., Canada, Australia and New Zealand).
 - a. Nordic institutions: Gymnasium English B and received grades of "VG" or "MVG".
 - b. For Sweden, "VG" = "C" and "MVG" = "A/B". Also, English B = English 6.
 - c. Singapore: Completed all years of study in Singapore schools. Completion of secondary school only will require a TOEFL or IELTS score.
- **International School:** Earned a high school diploma in an International School or similar, where **English is the primary language of instruction**. You must submit high school transcripts and other documentation, such as a letter on school's letterhead, stating that English was the primary language of instruction.
- **Completed advanced level of English as a Second Language (ESL)** or college-level English classes at a U.S. college or university. You must provide an official transcript to receive this waiver.
- **Received a degree from a college or university** in the U.S., the U.K., Canada, Australia or New Zealand. You must provide an official transcript to receive this waiver.
- **Are a resident of and completed all years of study** in a country (not listed above) whose official language is English.
