Historic Partnership MOU Signing with Taiwanese High Schools for GOL



College of San Mateo (CSM) was ranked #1 in California by Wallethub in 2020 from among 600+ community colleges. CSM is ranked #3 in the nation.



High School, and Chenggong High School in Taiwan held a virtual MOU Signing Ceremony. A top trade official of the US Commerce Department, Mr. Dough Wallace, spoke at the event and pointed out that online learning is part of the future and localized efforts are strongly encouraged. Vice Minister of Taipei Education Bureau reiterated his government support for the collaboration and followed through with a grant for students from these two schools to study GOL courses. Considering the many challenges brought on by the pandemic, both sides pulled off a first in doing a virtual celebration across time zones and language barriers. This historic event also took place during the celebration of Heping's 52nd School Anniversary (congratulations!!!). It wouldn't have been possible without the hard work of the Silicon Valley International Education Program (SVIEP) team, officials and staff of Heping and Chenggong High School, and support from both the US and Taiwan governments.
