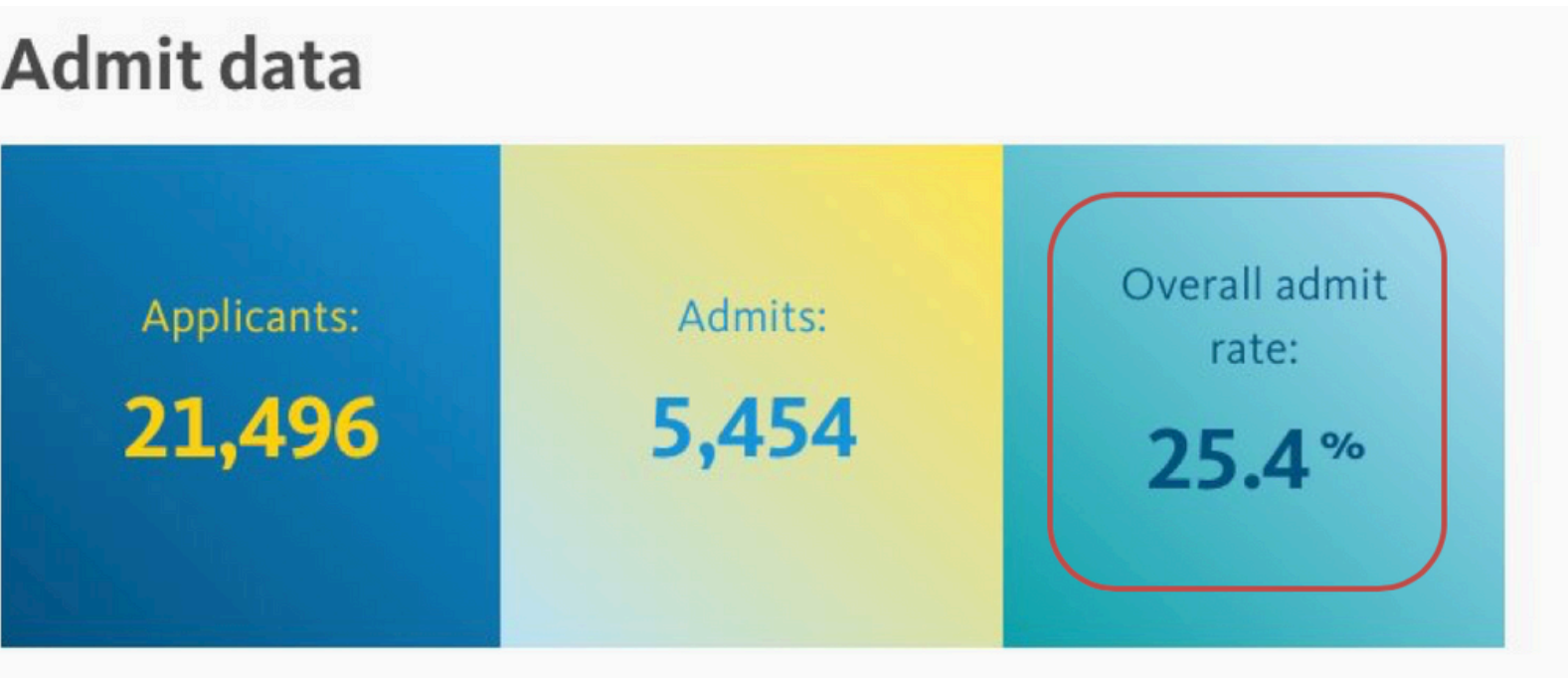

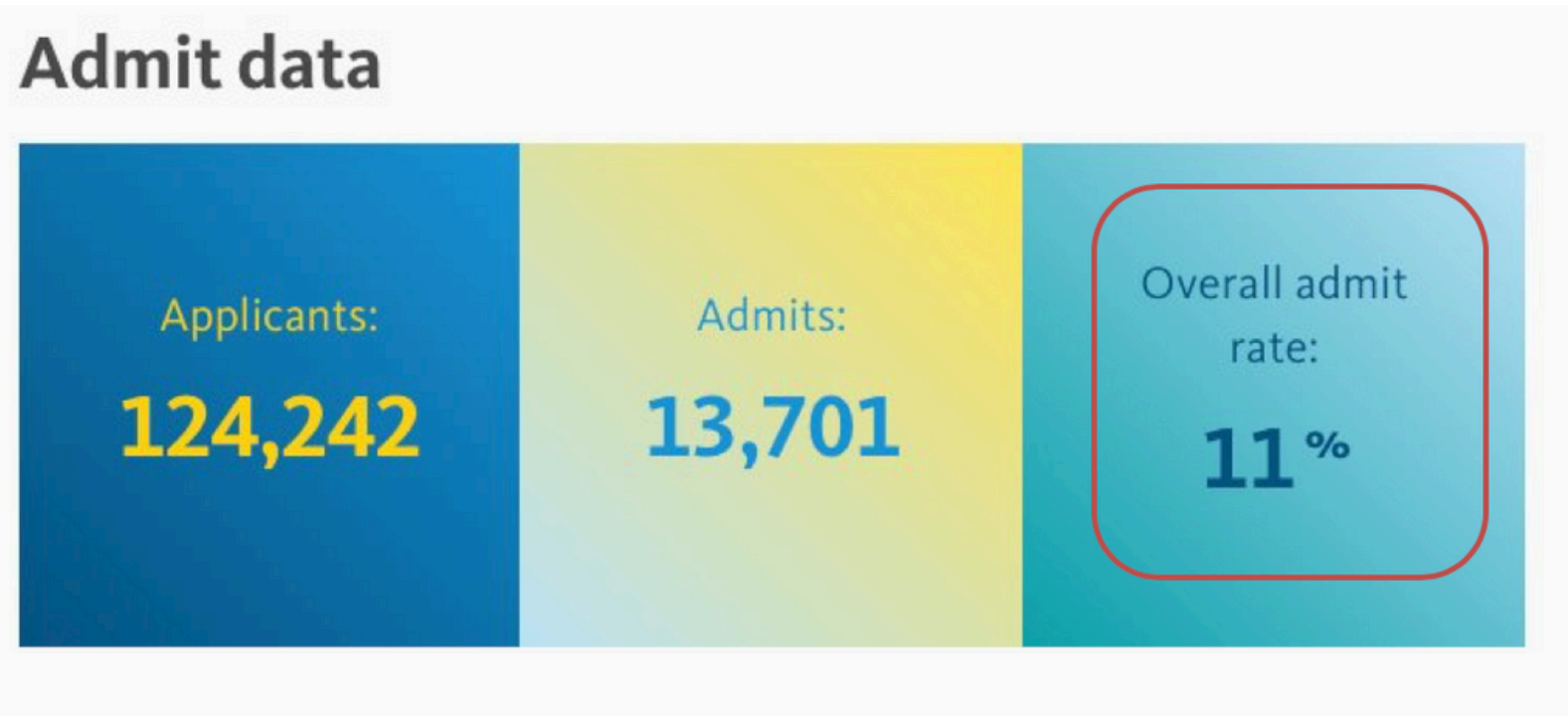
UC Berkeley Admission Rate

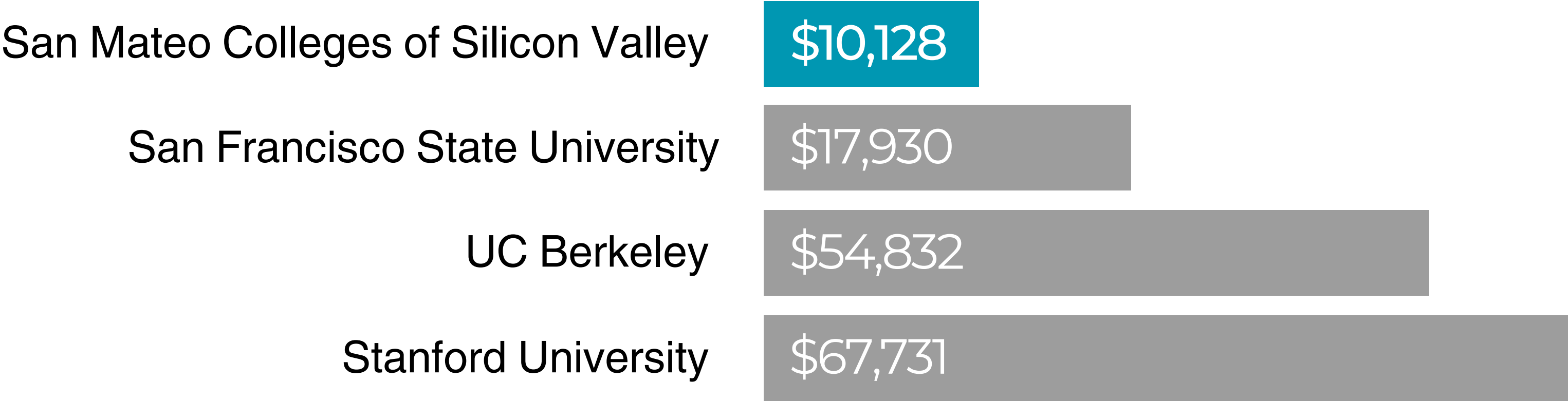
Global Online Learning (GOL)

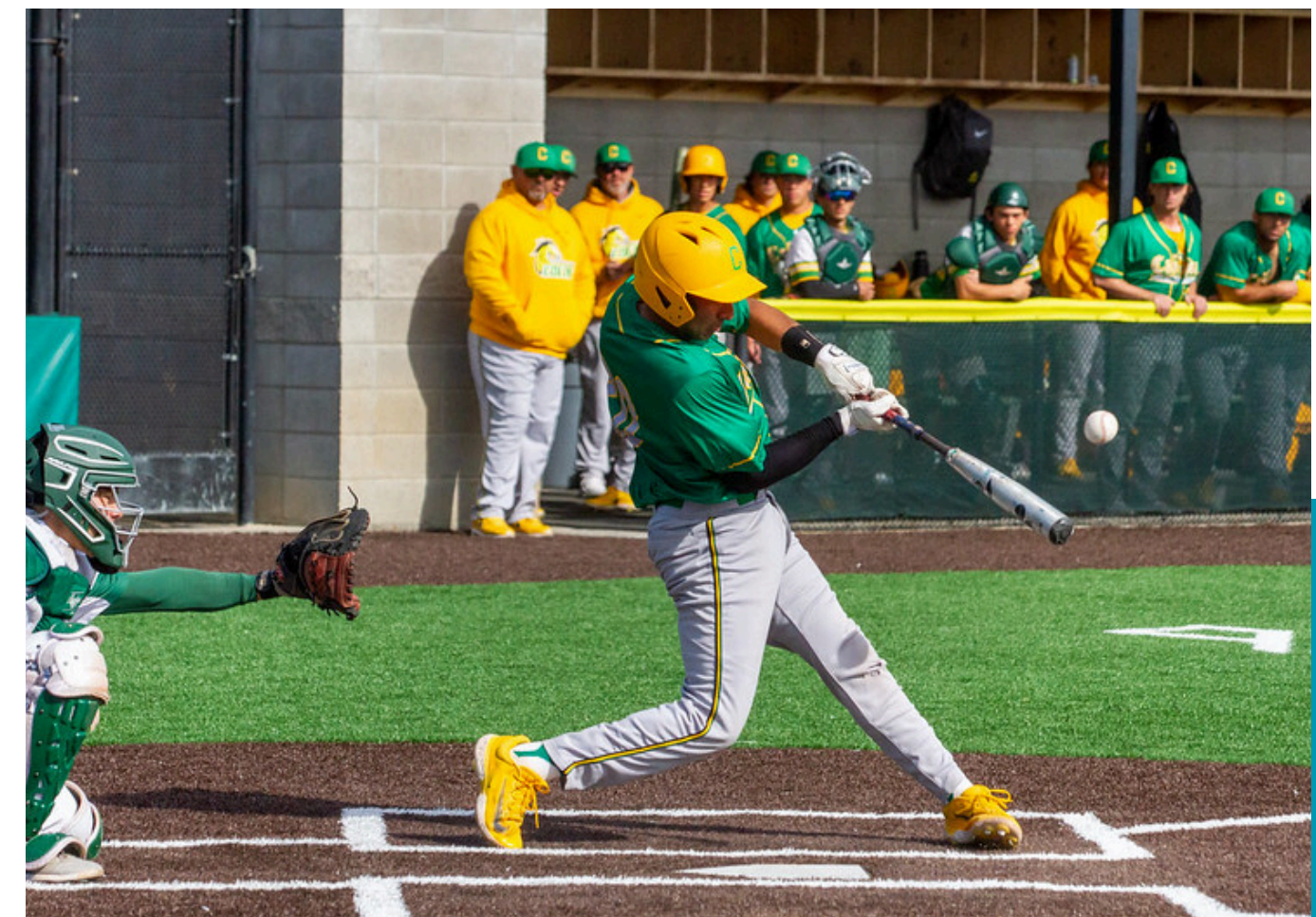

1. Online International Student Application Fee (\$50)
 - *Waived for Global Online Learning (GOL)*
2. Age Requirement - 16+ years old
3. English Proficiency Requirement - *TOEFL iBT 56, IELTS 5.5 or Duolingo 85*
4. Financial Requirement - \$32,500
5. HS completion if under age 18
6. Academic transcript(s) with English translation(s)
7. Copy of Passport

- 3. Pay the application fee (\$50) - Waived if applying for GOL
- 4. Submit the application online.
