



Scholarship Opportunities

Every year, San Mateo Colleges of Silicon Valley awards **over 50 institutional scholarships** to support our international students.

Award Amounts: \$125 to \$10,000

High Success Rate: Approximately 20% of our international students receive an award annually

One & Done: Submit a single application; our committee automatically matches you with every scholarship you're eligible for

Stackable: You can receive multiple scholarships at once!

Eligibility: Must be enrolled at Cañada College, College of San Mateo, or Skyline College

Examples:

The Lewis Family STEM Scholarship (CAN)

Award: \$1,500

This scholarship is for incoming, continuing, or transferring students majoring in a STEM field. Students must have demonstrated financial need and a minimum of 2.5 GPA.

AAUW/Kathleen A. Smith Memorial Scholarship Fund (CAN)

Award: \$7,000

This scholarship, supported by the American Association of University Women, San Mateo Branch, is for SMCCCD students who have attained a minimum GPA of 3.5, show financial need, and will transfer in the following fall term to a four-year institution of higher learning accredited by the American Association of Colleges and Universities.

Rao Madamala Memorial Scholarship Fund (CSM)

Award: \$6,000

This scholarship recognizes one continuing student each year. Eligible students must major in Biotechnology, Chemistry, and/or Pre-Pharmacy and maintain a minimum of 3.0 GPA. The award prioritizes candidates with a commitment to pursuing groundbreaking scientific research.

Rosalie O'Mahony Mathematics/Civil Engineering Scholarship (CSM)

Award: Multiple awards ranging from \$1,000 - \$10,000 each

The awardee must be a student majoring in Mathematics or Civil Engineering with upper division standing who will be transferring to a four-year college or university. The student is required to have an average GPA of B or better. The scholarship will be distributed in equal installments – one-half upon registration as a junior and the second half after successfully completing the junior year.

Iliff Award (SKY)

Award: \$890

Recipients of this award must be international (F-1 visa) students enrolled full-time, who have demonstrated financial need, and who are making satisfactory progress in a major that emphasizes technical training.

Joe McDonough AFT Social Justice Scholarship (SKY)

Award: \$5,000

Applicants must demonstrate involvement in an organization working to achieve social justice, helping to create a just society. This activity can be through a campus organization or club, or a community group/organization.
