Explanation of Program Fee and Tuition

Program fee is paid to AIFS— it covers housing, orientation, metro pass, sight-seeing tours, cultural activities programs, excursions and field trips, museum pass, medical insurance, and a variety of support services while abroad.

Tuition for twelve units is paid directly to the NCSAC college(s) at which you take your classes abroad – College of San Mateo, American River College Santa Rosa Junior College, or Diablo Valley College.
